

Greenways

Independent nonmotorized routes, mainly using disused railways and canal towpaths.

Safe, accessible and very attractive

Easy access to areas of outstanding natural beauty (e.g. mountainous areas, by way of tunnels and viaducts).



Whatever your age or physical condition. With family, friends or individually: greenways offer great facilities for cycling and hiking safely, all year round.



Greenways: an asset for sustainable tourism

- Gradients less than 3 %, rectilinear tracks, wide curves.
- Exceptional and respectful access to nature, due to the use of preexisting infrastructures integrated into the landscape allowing movement around the countryside, offering enjoyment of the culture and history of Europe.
